## **Required Materials:**

## **Homework:**

- Students are required to complete all questions at the end of each class. The homework will not be collected. Pathway Instructors will document completion of the homework on the student's *Student Pathway Tracker* (located in CCC's Pathway Binder).
- Students are required to complete the entire *Path to Belonging* homework before they graduate from *the Path to Belonging* and commence to the *Path to Involvement*.

## **Procedures:**

- Students must arrive within 15 minutes of the start of class and must remain in attendance during the entire length of the class; otherwise they will not receive credit for the class and the class will need to be retaken.
- If a student misses a class, a Pathway Instructor can setup a make-up class outside of the regularly scheduled Pathway classes. Students can continue attending the Pathway classes even if they miss a class.
- Students can attend an Encounter at any point of time during the course of *The Path to Belonging*; however students will not be able to attend the second Path (*The Path to Involvement*), without completion of the Encounter
- After completing the course: *The Path to Belonging* (attended all classes and finished all coursework), students are eligible to graduate from *The Path to Belonging* and receive the Right-hand of Fellowship (Calvary Christian Center membership). All students will receive a certificate for their completion of *The Path to Belonging at graduation*.
- If a student has completed *The Path to Belonging* and has attended an encounter, he/she can commence to *The Path to Involvement*.
- Graduation is tentatively scheduled every 8 weeks at Calvary Christian Center's Main Campus [2667 Del Paso Blvd. Sacramento, CA 95815] during Sunday's 6:30pm service. Please arrive promptly at the North campus at 6:00pm. We will be meeting to discuss the details of the graduation ceremony.
