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### GARLAND BOOTH MEMORIAL FUND SCHOLARSHIP

Academic Scholarships are available for Graduating High School Seniors entering a Junior College or (4) year College or University for the Fall 2017 semester. Any Calvary Christian Center member is eligible for the GARLAND BOOTH MEMORIAL FUND SCHOLARSHIP.

An application form may be obtained from the Church Office or the Information Desk in the foyer. Applications and essays addressed to the Scholarship Committee can be submitted until the deadline date of Friday, June 30, 2017 at 4:00pm.

The Scholarship Committee will review applications. Each qualified applicant will be notified to schedule an interview with the scholarship panel. The panel will complete a profile of each applicant based on academic excellence, activities and pursuits.

Applicants selected to receive this honorable award will be announced and recognized during a formal presentation at church in the month of July. All selected applicants will be notified of this date.

The following criteria will be evaluated by the committee to make the selections:

- The student must be a current and active member of the Church.
- The student must be currently enrolled in school with at least a 3.0 GPA for all work completed.
- The student must be accepted into a College or University for Fall 2017.
- The student must submit an application and essay illustrating: Strong Christian Identity, Moral Character and Leadership Qualities. (*Application and Essay must be typed and include date, name, address and telephone*)
- The student must attach copy of current transcripts and college acceptance letter. Verification of GPA and acceptance into college will be required.
- The scholarship honoree will be encouraged to update the Church of his/her college success.
